Fiscal Year 2013 in Review

2013 was a year of change for the health care industry. The implementation of the federal Accountable Care Act was new territory for us all. For behavioral health care in Ohio, it came in the form of integration of behavioral and physical health care. While some projects from the State, aimed at this goal, did not materialize, the concept is an important one for our clients. At Ravenwood we are exploring how to best implement this type of integration.

Same day access to services was implemented for most of our new clients in February. In most cases, an individual can call the agency and receive an intake and assessment later the same day. This process has made timely access to care, for those client who need it, a reality. We have also started a centralized scheduling process. Clients can call one number to schedule and manage all of their appointments at Ravenwood.

Intensive Services. Brittain Paul Ongoing Services. Both have extensive clinical and administrative experience in behavioral health care and bring strong skills to the team.

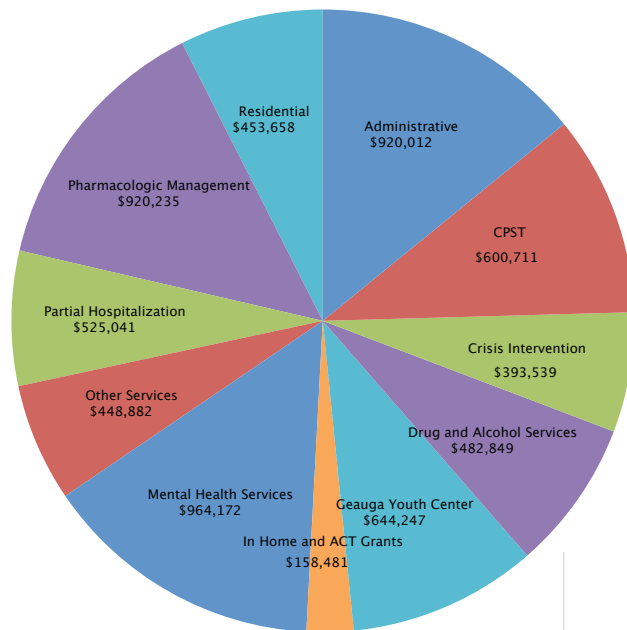


Nathan Dotson

We also are pleased to announce new financial leadership, Nathan Dotson began as our controller in December 2013. He has over ten years experience in the not-for-profit accounting field.

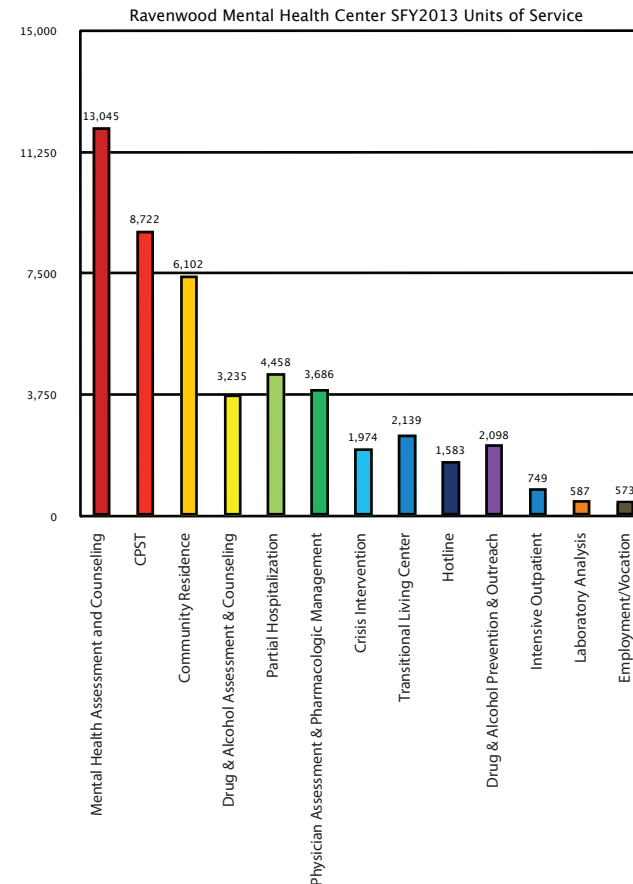
As we finish FY14, we look forward to working together to provide timely, state of the art and integrated health services to the residents of Geauga County.
