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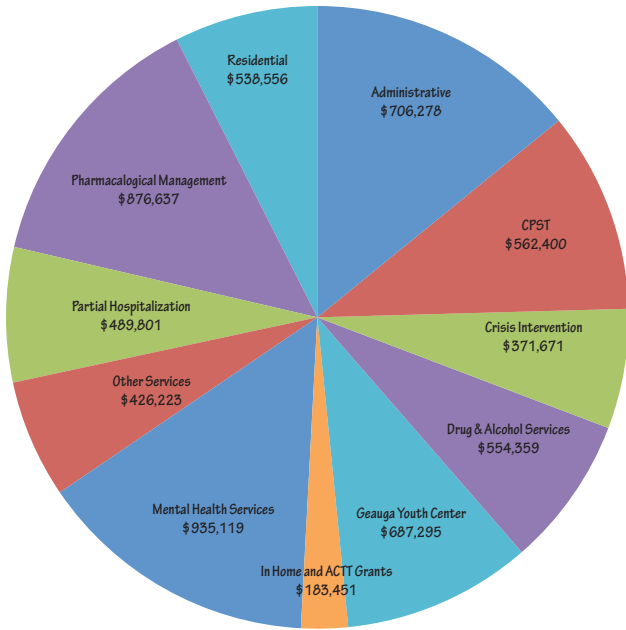

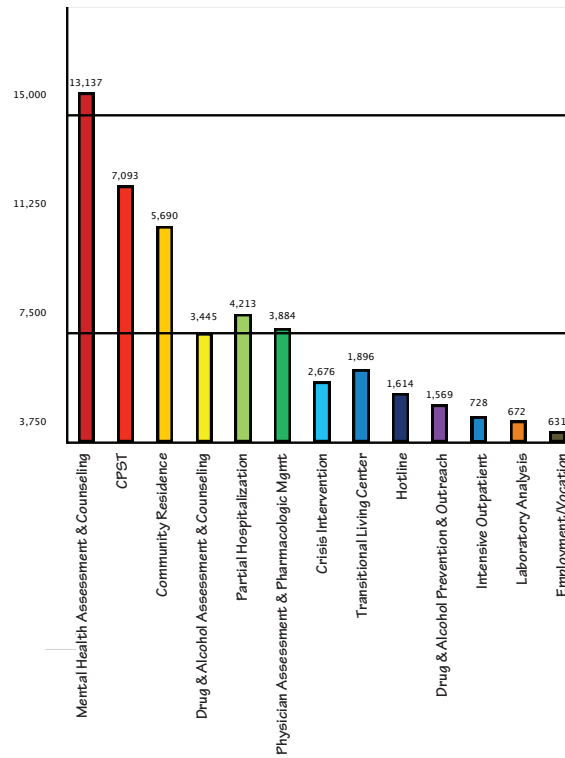

Fiscal Year 2014 in Review

Looking back, 2014 was a year of transition for the health care industry and expanded clinical expertise and services for Ravenwood.

Medicaid expansion and health care exchanges made an appearance and had a positive impact for many of our client's ability to access care. More individuals and families were able to obtain much needed behavioral health services.

Ravenwood staff worked to expand their skills in Trauma Informed Care. Most significantly, twenty-three clinicians at Ravenwood became Certified Trauma Specialists. Certification required five intensive days of training as well as a fairly long testing and certification process. The Geauga County Board of Mental Health and Recovery Services (GCBMHRs) made it possible to certify a large number of our staff by funding training opportunities.

We expanded our Transitional Living Center (TLC), from six to a nine-bed facility through a grant obtained by the GCBMHRs. The TLC is a 24/7 supervised facility for adults with severe and persistent mental illness. Transitional Beds are available for up to two years, and crisis beds for two weeks. This expansion has helped decrease the number of individuals who need psychiatric hospitalization. Many of these individuals can remain in their community with their existing health care providers, while their mental health improves.

Our progress is only possible because of the hard work, commitment and skills provided by our staff and the support of the Greater Geauga Community.
